



L2TP on Windows 7

This document contains instructions for configuring and connecting via L2TP for GTA Firewalls.

Configuring

1. Open the Windows Control Panel.
2. Go to Network and Internet > Network and Sharing Center.
3. Click Set up a new connection or network.

Set up a wireless, broadband, dial-up, ad hoc, or VPN connection; or set up a router or access point.

4. Select Connect to a workplace and click Next.



Connect to a workplace

Set up a dial-up or VPN connection to your workplace.

5. Click Use my Internet connection (VPN).

Connect using a virtual private network (VPN) connection through the Internet.



6. Enter the IP Address or Resolvable Hostname of the firewall in the Internet Address field, and a description for the VPN Connection.
7. Check Don't connect now; just set it up so I can connect later.

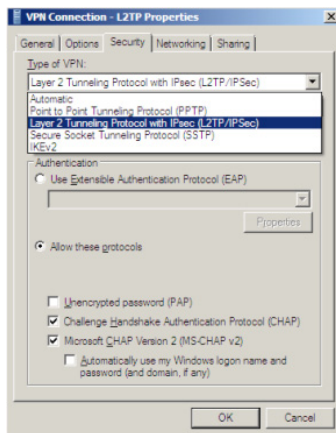

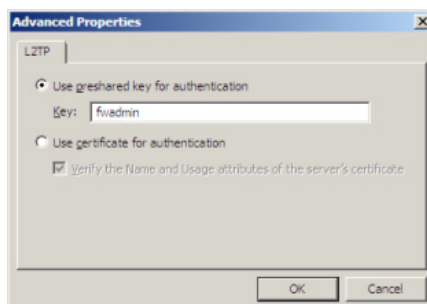
10. Click Create.

11. Navigate to Control Panel > Network and Internet > Network Connections

12. Right click on the connection and select properties. Click on the security tab.



13. Set the Pre-Shared Key configured in the firewall interface at **Configure>VPN>Remote Access>L2TP**.

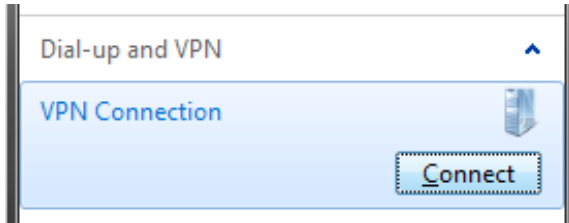


14. Click Ok.



Connecting

1. Left click on the Network icon.
2. Select the VPN you just created and click Connect.



3. Enter your L2TP/L2TP Password for your User on the Firewall in the Password field.
4. Then click Connect.
