

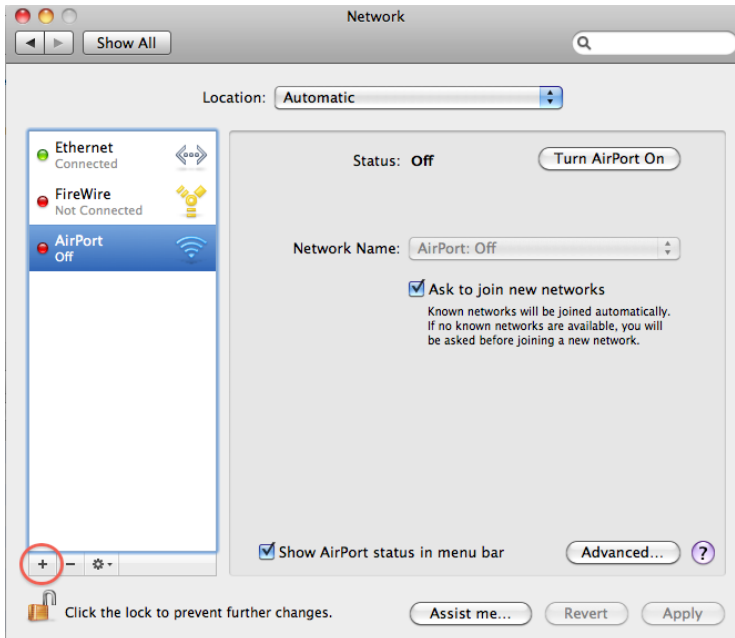


PPTP on Mac

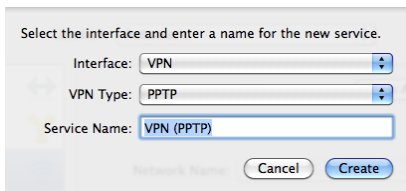
This document contains instructions for configuring and connecting via PPTP for GTA Firewalls.

Configuring

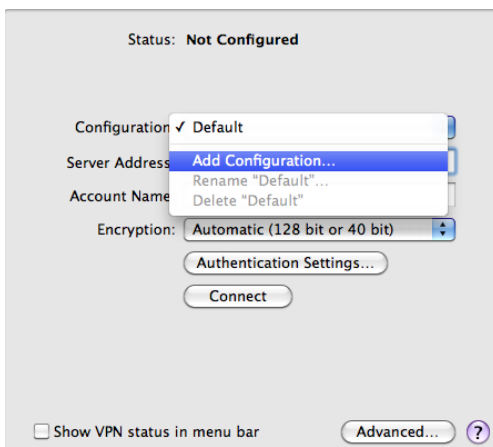
1. Launch System Preferences.
2. Open Network.
3. Click on the + icon.



4. In the Interface drop-down, select VPN. Under VPN Type select PPTP. Then hit Create.



5. Select Add Configuration... from the Configuration drop-down.





6. Enter a name for the configuration and hit Create.

7. Enter the Server Address (this is the firewall IP Address or Resolvable Name) and Account Name (this is your Users Identity from the firewall). Then hit Authentication Settings.

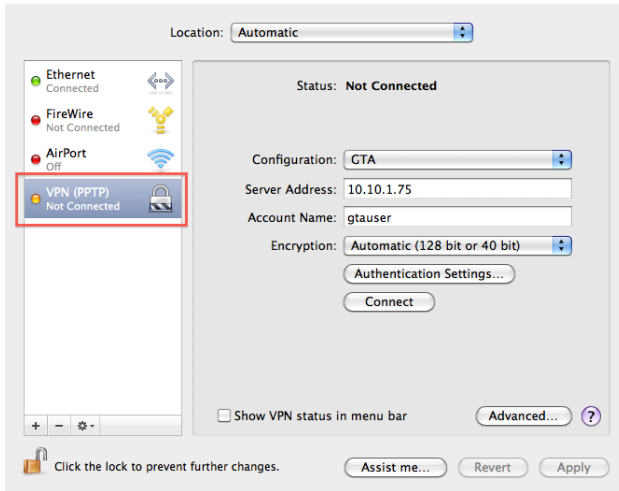
