



PPTP on Windows 7

This document contains instructions for configuring and connecting via PPTP for GTA Firewalls.

Configuring

1. Open the Windows Control Panel.
2. Go to Network and Internet > Network and Sharing Center.
3. Click Set up a new connection or network.



Set up a new connection or network

Set up a wireless, broadband, dial-up, ad hoc, or VPN connection; or set up a router or access point.

4. Select Connect to a workplace and click Next.



Connect to a workplace

Set up a dial-up or VPN connection to your workplace.

5. Click Use my Internet connection (VPN).



Use my Internet connection (VPN)

Connect using a virtual private network (VPN) connection through the Internet.



6. Enter the IP Address or Resolvable Hostname of the firewall in the Internet Address field, and a description for the VPN Connection.
7. Check Don't connect now; just set it up so I can connect later.

8. Enter your Users Identity from the firewall in User name.



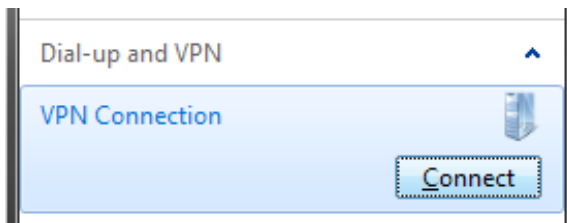
- Enter your Users L2TP/PPTP Password from the firewall in Password.

- Left click on the Network icon.
