



# PPTP on the iPhone

This document contains instructions for configuring and connecting via PPTP for GTA Firewalls.

## Configuring

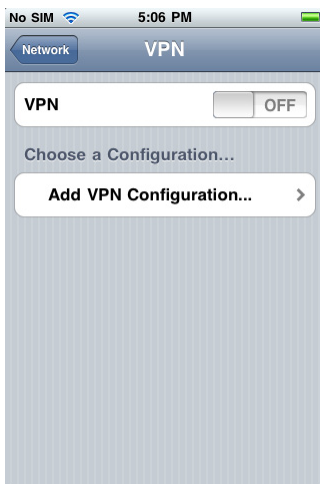
1. Launch the Settings Application



2. Go to General > Network > VPN



3. Select Add VPN Configuration





#### 4. Select PPTP

#### 5. Enter a Description

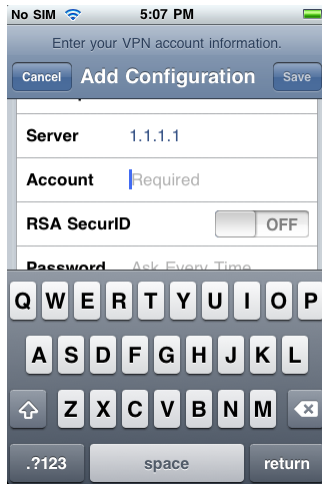

#### 6. Enter the Server Address (this is the firewall IP Address or Resolvable Name)

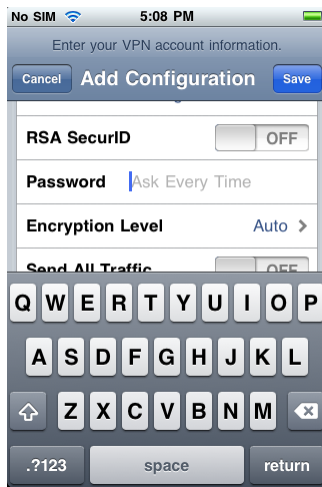
